

How to access the eWON Website from a PDA Browser

The default website of the eWON is designed to be viewed on a PC browser.

But the eWON also contains some special web pages which have been designed to be displayed on a PDA Browser.

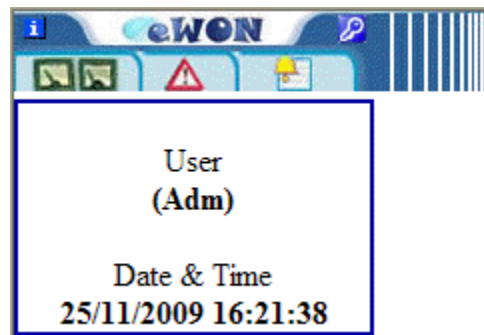
To get access to those web pages, add "/indexpda.htm" in your Browser at the end of the eWON IP address.

For example: <http://10.0.0.53/indexpda.htm>

- Note -

If the eWON is supposed to be connected mainly from a PDA Browser, you can also make these web pages the default home page of the eWON.

The Web page displayed on the PDA Browser will look like this:



The Menu bar on the top of the screen will allow to display the different available web pages:

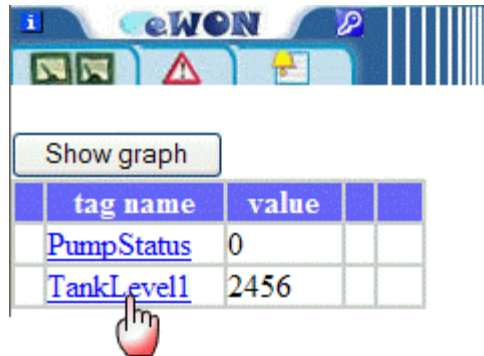


- **1:** The eWON Info page, which displays the eWON Identification, serial number, etc
- **2:** The eWON View IO page, which displays the tag values and allows also to change a value
- **3:** Alarm Summary page, which displays the current alarm state and allows to

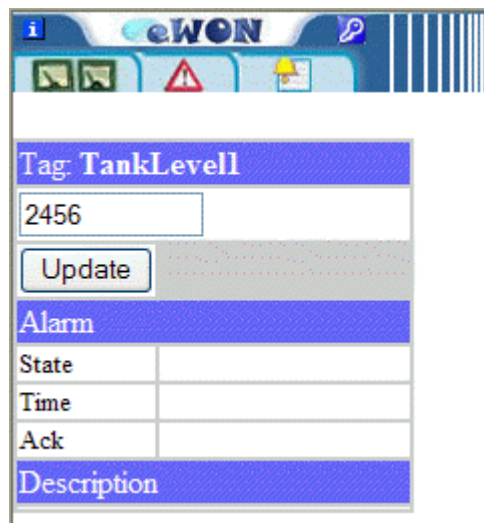
acknowledge alarms

- **4:** Alarm History page
- **5:** Log off button

To change the value of a Tag, click on the Tag link to open the web page which allows to modify the value:



Enter the new value in the upper entry field and click the Update button.
