

eSync - Apache and PHP upgrade procedure

eSync Upgrade Procedure : Apache 2.2.25 + PHP 5.3.27

1. Download and install the MS VC9 Redistributable Package
<http://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=5582>
2. Download and install the MS VC10 Redistributable Package
<http://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=8328>
3. Stop the eSync Apache Web Server service with the Command prompt:
net stop eSyncApache
4. Backup eSync, especially the Apache2\bin\ sub-directory:
5. Rename
 - C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\bin\ to C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\bin-2.0\
 - C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\modules\ to C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\modules-2.0\
6. Unzip the new package (eSyncApacheUpdate.zip) into C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\
This package can be downloaded on [support website](#).
This package installs the new contents for subdirs bin/ and modules/
7. Update eSyncApache executable name in service definition
8. The Apache exe is now httpd.exe instead of apache.exe. Execute those steps to update the service definition accordingly:
 - Open Regedit
 - Browse to *My Computer\HKLM\System\CurrentControlSet\Service\eSyncApache*
 - Edit value ImagePath: Change the exe name apache.exe into httpd.exe
e.g.: "C:\Program Files\eSync\Apache2\bin\httpd.exe" -k runservice -f "C:\Program Files\eSync\Apache2\conf\httpd.conf"
(The path remains unchanged)
9. Update the Apache config file: C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\Apache2\conf\httpd.conf
Comment out those 3 lines (insert a # at the start of each line):
 - LoadModule access_module modules/mod_access.so
 - LoadModule auth_module modules/mod_auth.so
 - LoadModule imap_module modules/mod_imap.so

At the end of the set of LoadModule lines, add the following:
LoadModule authz_host_module modules/mod_authz_host.so

In the "LoadModule php5_module ..." towards the end of the file, replace

php5apache2.dll by php5apache2_2.dll

10. Set your time zone in the PHP config:
Edit *C:\Program Files(x86)\eSync\PHP\php.ini*: uncomment and fill the line
date.timezone
e.g.: date.timezone=Europe/Brussels
11. Restart eSync:
Command prompt: net start eSyncApache
