eWON 2005 - Security LED

The eWON 2005 and 4005 types had a supplementary security LED. On the 2005CD (4005CD) versions this LED has been removed.

The following scenario exists for this led.

WAN Protection level	Discard all traffic excepted VPN and initiated traffic (ex: EMail)
	 Discard all traffic excepted VPN and initiated traffic (ex: EMail) and ICMP (Ping)
	Allow all traffic on WAN connection (no protection)

The scenario depends only on the eWON configuration:

Scenario	Description
OFF	Allow all traffic is selected
Blink 1 sec. Green 1 sec. OFF	Discard all but VPN and initiate or Discard all but VPN and initiate and PING
Solid Green	WAN interface is not connected
