

## Select the Operator for GSM modem

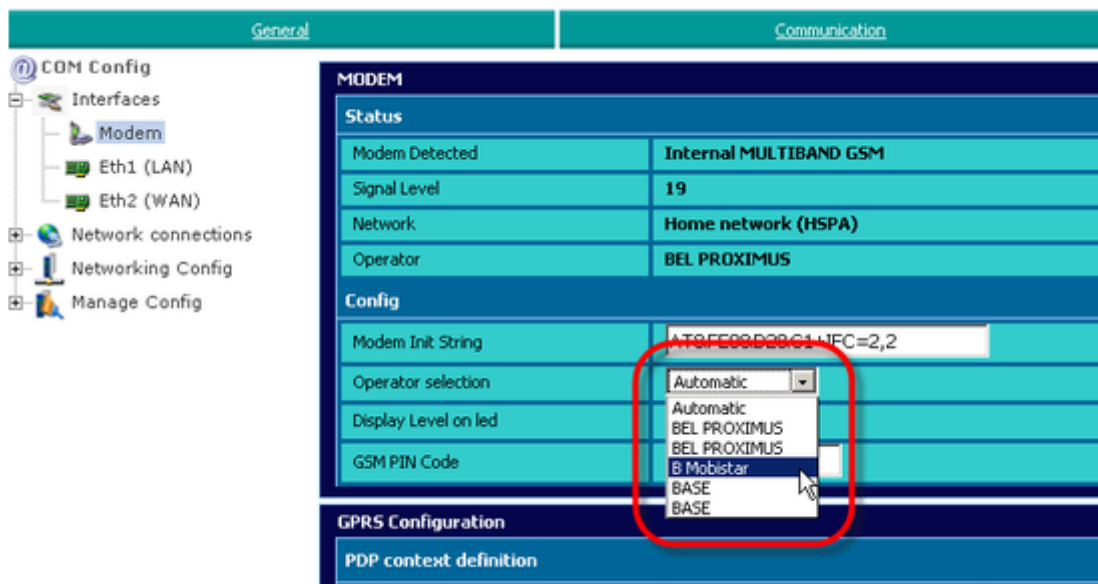
When your eWON is configured with your SimCard and is placed on a foreign country, the Roaming will ensure you a connection.

But as the choice of the foreign Operator for this roaming is automatic (by default), you may be roamed on an Operator not supporting UMTS instead of an Operator supporting UMTS.

Also, some Operator could be cheaper and then it could be enough to use it preferably.

So, if needed, you can use the "Operator selection" combobox in the eWON to select the Operator (with better bandwidth or lower costs).

In the Modem page (SystemSetup->Communication->Interfaces->Modem), you can choose the Operator amongst the list of operators found by the modem
