

Example of a Task Planner entry

Since the firmware 5.7s0, we have implemented a Task Planner functionality in the eWON. This allows you to schedule the actions like sending an eMail, a SMS or a file by FTP.

To achieve that, go to the Task Planner page,



and configure one of the 10 entries.

For instance, if I want to receive every monday the historical logging of the Tag "Temperature" of the last week:

I will set the Timer Interval to "0 0 * * 1".

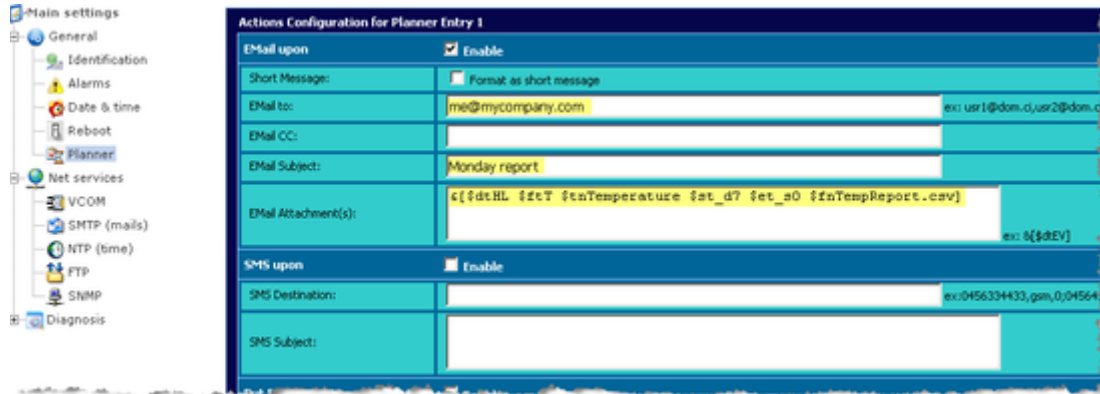
Timer Interval syntax is the following: mm hh dd MMM DDD

- mm is the minute
- hh is the hour (0-23)
- dd is the day of the month (1-31)
- MMM is the month (1-12) or (jan,feb,mar,apr, may, jun, jul, aug, sep, oct, nov, dec)
- DDD is the day of week (1-7) where 1 is monday

- Note -

*each field can be replaced by the operator * (asterisk) to specify "all values". The complete list of operators and more syntax examples can be found in the [Reference Guide \(RG-001\)](#)*

Once the Interval is defined, click on the Edit Action button (point 5 in the above image) to set the action.



The screen is the same as for the Alarm Action. You can Send an eMail, Send an SMS, send a file by FTP or trigger an SNMP trap.

Click on the Update button and, in this example, your eWON will send an eMail every monday at 00:00 with the historical data of the Temperature Tag of the last week.
