eWON preconfigured via SD Card to enable the USB port

This document provides parameters to set up in a comcfg.txt which will allow an eWON to be preconfigured to be connected through USB.

The preconfiguration is possible with the help of an SD Card which the comcfg.txt file is copied on.

If you need help on how to configure an eWON via an SD Card, please refer to the <u>AUG-062-0-EN-(eWON configured by SD Card)</u>.

Here are the parameters to set in the comcfg.txt file so the eWON can establish a USB connection:

UsbIPEnable:1
UsbIpLogLevel:0
UsbIpStartPort:6000
UsbIpPwd:#_1_//8=

- Note -

The UsbIpPwd is the password of the USB device. You can write down the clear text password in the comcfg.txt file and the eWON will automatically encode it.
